

The regular meeting of the Michigan City Council was held Monday, June 7, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Council President Scott Gilbertson. Members present were Maria Vasichuk and Scott Midstokke. Absent were Allen Orwick and Elaine Larson. Also present was Dan Johnson.

The minutes from May 3rd, 24th and 28th were not read at this time.

Dan Johnson stated that Visu-Sewer will be here through Thursday of this week to televise and prep the sewer mains to be ready for another crew that will be here in about 3 or 4 weeks to begin re-lining the mains. Quam Construction will also be back around that time to finish the sewer main replacement and begin work at the lagoon. Dan also presented a request for payment from Quam Construction for work that has been completed. Maria Vasichuk made a motion to approve the payment request. Scott Midstokke seconded the motion with Vasichuk and Midstokke voting in favor. Dan left the meeting at this time.

The monthly financial statement and listing of bills were reviewed. Scott Midstokke made a motion to approve the financial statement and listing of bills. Maria Vasichuk seconded the motion with Midstokke and Vasichuk voting in favor.

Jay did not contact Black Mountain regarding the water billing software but will check with them to see if they can attend a special meeting on the 16th.

Other old business discussed included contacting Ohnstad Electric about the hook-up to the civic center for an emergency generator, work that needs to be done to the new cemetery addition including having the area worked up, having Ken Schmidt do some leveling and planting grass and finally having another dumpster for spring cleanup.

Maria mentioned that besides a 100 cup coffee maker there seems to be other items missing from the civic center kitchen.

Maria received an e-mail from American Security Cabinets on a price for a payment drop box for water bills. Jay will also check with the bank on the charge the city currently pays them for this service.

Otter Tail Power Company is placing a representative at the Michigan location so the city will no longer be using the building. Jay is to contact Prairie Builders and Ohnstad Electric for bids for insulating and heating the city shop.

There was discussion on the water and sewer emergency from the past 2 weeks. Jay also stated that he is meeting with FEMA on the 16th.

The Council discussed complaints that they received regarding dogs.

Maria Vasichuk made a motion to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
