ORDINANCE # 162

SNOW REMOVAL

Section 1. PURPOSE

An Ordinance for Snow Removal on the city streets of the City of Michigan City.

Section 2: REGULATION

Snow removal on City Streets shall be regulated by the City Council and City Superintendent.

Snow will be removed from city streets, not alleys, residents sidewalks or residents driveways.

Section 3: SCHEDULING

Snow removal will be completed on the City Streets as weather conditions permit.

Snow removal shall be the responsibility of the City Superintendent.

Section 4: RESPONSIBILITY OF RESIDENTS:

It will be the resident's responsibility to remove vehicles from city streets to allow for snow removal.

Residents should park vehicles in their driveways or apartment parking lots.

Should vehicles remain on the city streets during snow removal and become blocked due to plowing city streets, it will be the resident's responsibility to remove the snow around their vehicle. It will not be the City's responsibility to return to remove snow.

Should vehicles be parked on the City Streets making it unsafe to plow snow, said street will not be plowed. It will not be the City's responsibility to return at a later time to plow said street.

Should a resident's property, driveway or sidewalk receive snow from snow plowing or snow blowing the city streets, it is the resident's responsibility to remove snow.

Residents shall not remove the snow from their property, driveway or sidewalks onto the City Streets.

Section 5: DEFINITIONS:

The use of RESIDENT shall mean business, homeowner and renter of house or apartment.

The term of CITY STREETS shall mean streets not alleys, sidewalks or driveways.
