

Ordinance No 149

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MICHIGAN CITY,
NORTH DAKOTA:

With the exception of mail boxes which meet the requirements of the United States postal Service for receiving and distributing mail through the united States postal Service system, no person shall erect or permit the installation of any receptacles upon any berm or boulevard abutting any city street within the city limits of the city of Michigan, any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$5.00 per day, commencing one (1) day after receiving written notice of such violation from the city Auditor of the city of Michigan city.
