

SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

SNOW REMOVAL WILL ***NOT START*** UNTIL ***AFTER*** MAIN SNOW FALL OR STORM ENDS, UNLESS AN EMERGENCY ARISES. DOWNTOWN AND EMERGENCY ROUTES ARE FIRST PRIORITIES

DO NOT BLOW SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS ONTO THE STREETS.

Please pile snow in your yard. Adding to the snow already in the streets only slows the snow removal process or blocks the streets if they have been plowed

Please, if you know snow is coming do not park on the street.

Please, locate extension cords away from curbs, do not leave in gutters.

Garbage containers need to be left on the berm or in your driveway for easy access by the garbage truck.

If vehicles or garbage containers are in the way of snow removal, the City will not return to “re-do” snow removal on the streets.

ALLEYS WILL NOT BE PLOWED



The City will use the quickest and most efficient methods of snow removal with the least inconvenience.
