GENERAL INFORMATION

GARBAGE: Garbage is to be placed out Tuesday evening. It is picked up early Wednesday morning. The garbage must be bagged, tied and placed on the curbside or end of your driveway. You must provide your own containers. We ask that you please use cans and not place your garbage out in plastic bags in an effort to keep vermin from destroying your trash prior to pickup. Please remove all containers away from the curbside and off the boulevard until garbage day. Grass, leaves, tree branches must be disposed of at the City Landfill east of town. Please do not put any other garbage at the City Landfill.

Water billing: The Water Meters are read on the 15th day of the month. The water bills are sent out at that time and are due by the 10th of each month. When a bill is 60 days delinquent, a list is printed and notices are sent to each homeowner along with the current month's water billing. The notice will state the amount due and shut off date. If the water is shut off, a reconnect fee of \$200.00 will be charged along with the total water bill due, being paid in full before water will be turned on. **Turn on of water services will only be done during office hours.**

There is a \$200.00 Water Application & Deposit fee. The water deposit is refunded at the end of service.

The Utility rates per month are: Water Service \$30.00 for 2,000 gallons of water, plus \$3.00 per 1000 gallons; Sewer Charge - \$12.00; Sewer 14-1 - \$10.25; Garbage - \$17.50; Meter Replacement Charge - \$3.00; Mosquito - \$4.00; Emergency Fund - \$2.00; Service Charge \$1.00.

Ordinance #132 – Water Services – is available to view at the City Office or on the Michigan City Website.

ANIMAL LICENSE: A license is required for all dogs and cats. These licenses need to be renewed every year. A license fee of \$10.00 per pet is charged. A rabies vaccination certificate must also be provided prior to issuance of the license. The City holds an annual Vet Clinic for vaccinations and the date will be posted on the Civic Center door, Ness Press, Facebook and the Michigan City Website.

Ordinance #130 – Pets – is available to view at the City Office or on the Michigan City Website.

SNOW REMOVAL POLICY: Removal is done during heavy periods of snowfall. Any vehicle left on City Streets during any snow removal operation will be plowed around. Residents shall not blow snow from their property, driveways, etc onto City Streets. Ordinance #162 – Snow Removal is available to view at the City Office or on the Michigan City Website.
