A Special meeting of the Michigan City Council was held on October 14, 2014 at 5:00 pm in the City Office. Mayor Lauri Rysavy called the meeting to order. In attendance were Council members Diane Schock, Josh Forde, Kathy Gilbertson, and Scott Gilbertson. Also in attendance was Ken Hietala.

Mayor Rysavy updated the Council on the County Commissioners meeting she attended on October 7, 2014 in regards to property in the City that has been condemned. These two properties have gone back to the County due to non-payment of taxes. These properties are N 55ft Lots 20-22 Block 11 Original Townsite and Lots 3-5 Block B East Michigan. An appraisal hearing is scheduled for 11:30am, November 6, 2014 at the Courthouse. Estimates for demolition and disposal of the properties were discussed. Mayor Rysavy will secure a written estimate from the Forest River Colony for demolition. Scott Gilbertson made a motion to demolish the above properties, Josh Forde seconded the motion, motion carried.

Flushing of the remaining sewer manholes was discussed. Cathi will need assistance in order to complete.

A text message regarding the removal and hanging of the Nelson County Quilt Trail banners was read by Mayor Rysavy. Maria Vasichuk and Sylvia Daws will organize volunteers and with the help of the Michigan Implement each Fall and Spring the banners will be taken care of.

Scott Gilbertson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Kathy Gilbertson, motion carried.
