

Ordinance No 145

Adopting the revised alcoholic beverages of the city Of Michigan, North Dakota, of 2003, and repealing all previously adopted alcoholic beverages ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MICHIGAN, NORTH DAKOTA, in regular meeting September 8, 2003. This ordinance and the ordinances hereby adopted shall be known and cited as the revised alcoholic beverages ordinances of 2003.

Enactment. The following sections of chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century code as now enacted and hereafter amended, are hereby adopted and incorporated into this ordinance: 5-01-01, 5-01-02, 5-01-05.1, 5-01-05.2, 5-01-05.4, 5-01-08, 5-01-08.2, 5-01-15.

The following sections of chapter 5-02 of the north Dakota Century Code as now enacted and hereafter amended, are herby adopted and incorporated into this ordinance: 5-02-01, 5-02-02, 5-02-03, 5-02-05.1(1), (2) and (3), 5-02-07.1, 5-02-09, 5-02-10, 5-02-11, 5-02-12. Pursuant to Section 5-02-09, there shall be permitted within the city limits of Michigan, one (1) exclusive on and off sale beer and liquor license for an annual fee of \$2,075.00, (\$2000.00 for the exclusive on and off sale liquor license, and \$75.00 for the exclusive on and off sale of beer license.)

The fee for a qualified alcoholic beverage licensee to engage in the sale of alcoholic beverages at events specified in the permit, pursuant to Section 5-02-01.1, shall be \$25.00 per event.

Pursuant to Section 5-02-03, the licensee fee to sell alcoholic beverages on Sundays shall be \$5.00 for each Sunday the licensee sells alcoholic beverages.

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its final passage.
