

Ordinance No. 153

Adopting the revised alcoholic beverages ordinances of the City of Michigan, North Dakota of 2006, and repealing all previously adopted alcoholic beverages ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MICHIGAN, NORTH DAKOTA, in regular meeting February 6, 2006. This ordinance and the ordinances hereby adopted shall be known and cited as the revised alcoholic beverages ordinances of 2006.

Enactment. The following sections of Chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code as now enacted and hereafter amended, are hereby adopted and incorporated into this ordinance: 5-01-01, 5-01-02, 5-01-05.1, 5-01-05.2, 5-01-05.4, 5-01-08, 5-01-08.1, 5-01-08.2, 5-01-10, 5-01-15.

The following sections of Chapter 5-02 of the North Dakota Century Code as now enacted and hereafter amended, are hereby adopted and incorporated into this ordinance: 5-02-01, 5-02-01.1, 5-02-02, 5-02-03, 5-02-05.1(1), (2), and (3), 5-02-07.1, 5-02-07.2, 5-02-09, 5-02-10, 5-02-11 and 5-02-12. Pursuant to Section 5-02-09, there shall be permitted within the city limits of Michigan, on and off sale beer licenses for an annual fee of \$75. Pursuant to Section 5-02-09, there shall be permitted within the city limits of Michigan, on and off sale liquor licenses for an annual fee of \$2,000 prorated by the number of licenses issued each year with a minimum annual fee of \$200. All licenses shall be issued on a calendar year basis. Liquor on and off sale licenses issued during a calendar year will be prorated and refunds issued to previous license holders.

The fee for a qualified alcoholic beverage licensee to engage in the sale of alcoholic beverages at events specified in the permit, pursuant to Section 5-02-01.1 shall be \$25 per event.

Pursuant to Section 5-02-03, the license fee to sell alcoholic beverages on Sundays shall be \$5 for each Sunday the licensee sells alcoholic beverages.

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its final passage. *or 25⁰⁰ a year for Sundays.*
