ORDINANCE #162 REVISED
SNOW REMOVAL

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

AN ORDINANCE FOR SNOW REMOVAL ON THE CITY STREETS OF THE CITY OF MICHIGAN CITY.

SECTION 2: REGULATION

SNOW REMOVAL ON CITY STREETS SHALL BE REGULATED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY SUPERINTENDENT. SNOW WILL BE REMOVED FROM CITY STREETS, NO ALLEYS, RESIDENTS SIDEWALKS OR RESIDENTS DRIVEWAYS.

SHOULD A RESIDENTS PROPERTY, DRIVEWAY OR SIDEWALK RECEIVE SNOW FROM SNOW PLOWING OR SNOW BLOWING THE CITY STREETS, IT IS THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO REMOVE SNOW.

SECTION 3: SCHEDULING

SNOW REMOVAL WILL BE COMPLETED ON THE CITY STREETS AS WEATHER CONDITIONS PERMIT. SNOW REMOVAL SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CITY SUPERINTENDENT.

SECTION 4: RESPONSIBILITY OF RESIDENTS:

RESIDENTS SHALL NOT REMOVE THE SNOW FROM THEIR PROPERTY, DRIVEWAY OR SIDEWALKS ONTO CITY STREETS.

IT WILL BE THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO REMOVE VEHICLES FROM CITY STREETS TO ALLOW FOR SNOW REMOVAL. RESIDENTS SHOULD PARK VEHICLES IN THEIR DRIVEWAYS OR APARTMENT PARKING LOTS.

1. PARKING LIMITS FOR OWNER, DRIVER OR ANY OTHER PERSON HAVING UNDER HIS CONTROL OR CHARGE ANY VEHICLE OF ANY KIND WHATEVER, SHALL NOT CAUSE, PERMIT OR ALLOW SUCH VEHICLE TO STAND OR REMAIN IN ANY ONE PLACE FOR A LONGER PERIOD THAN 48 HOURS UPON ANY STREET OR ALLEY IN THE CITY OF MICHIGAN.

2. THE TERM MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL MEAN ANY DEVICE UPON OR BY WHICH ANY

PERSON OR PROPERTY MAY BE TRANSPORTED OR DRAWN UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

3. MOTOR VEHICLES FOUND PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

FIRST OFFENSE: FIRST TIME OFFENDER SHALL BE ISSUED A WARNING.

SECOND OFFENSE: SECOND TIME OFFENDER SHALL BE ISSUED A TICKET CALLING FOR A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00)

THIRD OFFENSE: THIRD TIME OFFENDER SHALL PAY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) PLUS THE TOWING CHARGE FOR REMOVING THE VEHICLE.

4. PENALTY:

ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF VIOLATING OR OF FAILING TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00.

SECTION 5: DEFINITIONS:

THE USE OF RESIDENT SHALL MEAN BUSINESS, HOMEOWNER AND RENTER OF HOUSE OR APARTMENT.

THE TERM OF CITY STREETS SHALL MEAN STREETS NOT ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS OR DRIVEWAYS.
